Moderator Message

There is a reason that we have "Community" in our name. We are a church congregation committed to supporting the individuals and families living in Tully and neighboring communities. Whether we are offering our building to house meetings and gatherings or organizing member time and talent to provide needed resources, TUCC helps promote the health of our community. Here are just a few of our efforts.

The first Sunday of the month, food and supplies are collected for the community food pantry housed at St. Leo's.

TUCC created an emergency need fund called Fishermen's Net. Church representatives work with P.E.A.C.E. headquartered in the village to identify and address emergency needs of community individuals and families. Vouchers are provided for food, gas, or clothing. On occasion, money is provided to pay a portion of National grid bill or rental payments. St. Leo's Outreach often partners with us to help.

Each fall the church participates in the Backpack/School Supply Program to ensure that local children are ready for school. The Mission and Outreach Board coordinates our efforts.

The church represented by Sally Greene helps coordinate the Red Cross blood drive in Tully on a regular basis.

The Ladies Circle works on Brother's Keepers Quilts for the Rescue Mission. They produce sleeping bags stuffed with sweatpants, sweatshirt, socks, hat, and gloves. Each sleeping bag takes about three months to make. They group meets the first Monday of the Month and the meeting includes time to socialize over lunch. Travel size toiletries are also collected and routinely taken to the Rescue Mission. These can be dropped off to the office anytime. Nancy Chawgo is the contact person.

The church collects TABS from cans of all types: soup, veggies, tuna, beverages for the Solvay Shriners. There is a large jar in the Fellowship Hall for people to drop off TABS. The Shriner's convert these tabs into funds to buy transportation for children needing dialysis.

Mission and Outreach Board guide the church in filling and sending Flood Buckets to areas afflicted by hurricanes and heavy rains. John Burgett has mobilized the church and community to gather the needed supplies.

At Thanksgiving and Christmas TUCC supports the efforts of Peace to provide Thanksgiving Food Baskets and Angel Tree Christmas Gifts.

We need every member of the congregation to pray for our community and join our efforts to bless and strengthen our neighbors.

Board Updates

Activity of Personnel Relations Board Tully United Community Church

This is a review of situations and active topics that the PRB is presently working on as of Of November 10, 2020.

- 1. We are working to support the new church secretary Cindy Travers and the church's transition to a new secretary.
 - a. Directing Cindy as needed to support her training and familiarity with the church and congregation
 - b. Working and supporting Lorraine Bamler's group of office volunteers that help Cindy acclimate while they help with her daily/weekly tasks
 - Communicate and support our previous secretary Dawn Cox in orienting Cindy to tasks and
 questions as they come up during the Transition. Dawn works with Cindy for a modest number of
 hours as needed virtually from Florida
- 2. Researching and discussing methods of reducing our payroll processing expense presently costing the church \$165.00 per month. A plan to reduce this expense by 39% is being finalized presently.
- 3. Preparing for and working with Council on developing the guidelines and logistics of the pastoral search committee-supporting the process of negotiating with the pastor to transition from interim to assigned pastor.

Board of Stewards Summary of Current Projects

<u>Memorials and Bequests:</u> We're in the process of revising the current policy, including a letter to go to the family of the deceased informing them of their options as to what specific fund the contributed monies can go to.

<u>Financial Campaign:</u> As the same basic campaign has been used the past several years, we are researching new ones, looking for an appropriate fit for small churches. This includes a time and talent survey that is being put together to help get members more involved with the church. Online donating has been set up and the congregation will be given instructions as to how to use it.

Fundraiser: We're planning another chicken BBQ for April.

<u>New Church Directory</u>: Photos were scheduled to be taken last May but it has been put on hold because of Covid.

Audit: This has been put on hold until we can meet together.

Branding Logo: This has also been put on hold.

TUCC Board of Trustees Highlights of 2019 into 2020

The following items have been effected by the Board of Trustees in the last year:

- Hear2Learn began using our facility.
- Installed new water line.
- New, (used), lockable, fire retardant, file cabinet for office.
- Repaired many sanctuary chairs.
- Continuing to use LED lamps as other types wear out.
- Reihlman Room has had walls repainted; ceiling repairs and spot painting; all cove base replaced with continuous rubber cove base.
- Continuing with normal routine maintenance items.
- A new challenge of getting the immersion baptismal functioning has led to the present findings of pump/heater unit may have to be replaced and there is no ground fault protection on the 240 volt feed to this unit. Continuing saga.
